The purpose of the trip was to promote greater foreign direct investment (FDI) in Northern Los Angeles County. Recently a number of foreign companies have opened shop in the region, including BYD Motors (China), Anywind Wind Power Electric Inc. (South Korea), and Kinkisharyo International (Japan). These companies are repurposing empty space, building new facilities, creating jobs along with purchasing goods and services from local businesses helping to grow the local economy.
